The Executive Office

- Consists primarily of: White House Staff, National Security Council, Office of Management and Budget (OMB)
- White House Office - Chief of Staff, Press Secretary - do NOT require _____ approval
- NSC - advise the president on _____ policy
- Office of Management and Budget - prepares the president's yearly budget
 - Biggest predictor for funding? _____

- _____ (1973) - passed over Nixon's veto - sought to limit the president's power to engage in military action
